- Board had a private firm conduct and independent audit
- Due to dues increases over the past 2 years the pool currently has:
 - \$87,751.93 in cash on hand \$34,300 has been set-aside for capital improvement
 - Current dues structure will allow the club to continue to meet its obligations as well as continuing to provide for future improvements.

Concessions:

- Ice-Cream proved to be successful once again
- Netting over \$5K in profit

Operations/Maintenance:

- Repaired 3 broken tables
- Ordered additional chairs
- Ordered replacement and extra umbrellas
- Reduced cost of Landscaping
 - Canceled services during drought conditions
 - Planted our own flowers in the pool deck pots
 - Did our own seeding and fertilizing
- Replaced gutters on Pavilion
- Power washed both roofs (pavilion and pool house)
- Power washed cement under pavilion
- Removed broken storage shed and hazardous wooden platform
- Replaced pump bearings to ensure proper pump function
 - Narrowly avoided a full replacement situation
- Trimmed Pine Trees along parking lot to ensure available parking
- Added secondary electric panel to support current and future electric needs
- Added outlets in supply room
- Added new tie down to flag pole so we could fly the flag.
